Day 5: Transfer to Yerevan – Armenia

Armenia – A country of ancient traditions and breathtaking landscapes, Armenia is known for its deep-rooted Christianity, UNESCO World Heritage sites, warm hospitality, and rich cultural heritage nestled among the Caucasus Mountains.

The location of Haghpat Monastery was chosen so that it overlooks the Debed River in northern Armenia's Lori region. It was built partway up a hillside on a site chosen to afford protection and concealment, but also because of the monks' monastic humility.

Sevanavank is a monastic complex located on a peninsula at the northwestern shore of Lake Sevan in the Gegharkunik Province of Armenia, not far from the town of Sevan. Initially the monastery was built at the southern shore of a small island.

Day 6: Erevan city tour

Garni Temple – Located just outside Yerevan, Garni is the only standing Greco-Roman temple in the former Soviet Union. Perched above the Azat River Gorge, it offers breathtaking views and is a symbol of Armenia's pre-Christian heritage.

Symphony of Stones – Found near the Garni Gorge, the Symphony of Stones is a natural wonder made up of tall basalt columns that resemble organ pipes. This geological formation looks like a man-made masterpiece but is entirely the work of nature.

Just a short drive away stands **Rabati Fortress in Akhaltsikhe** — a stunning blend of cultures and eras. Originally built in the 9th century, today it stands proudly restored with churches, mosques, museums, and gardens that reflect Georgia's multicultural past.

Together, Vardzia and Rabati offer a unique journey through stone and soul — a testament to Georgia's strength, resilience, and timeless beauty.
