DAY 01 ARRIVE - NAIROBI

0700hrs: Wake up to a sumptuous buffet breakfast at Movenpick Hotel & Residences and then check out.

0800hrs Depart after breakfast for Sweetwaters Serena Camp, which is located in the world famous Olpejeta conservancy. You will enjoy spectacular views along the road, you'll just love it!

The drive takes approximately 3.5 hrs

Ol Pejeta has been advocating for the plight of chimpanzees and other great apes since 1993 at the Sweetwaters Chimpanzee Sanctuary. The Sanctuary aims to provide a refuge for chimpanzees rescued from the black market, and is the only place in Kenya where these fascinating animals can be seen.

1130hrs approximately, Arrival at Sweetwaters Serena Camp in time for lunch

DAY 04 SWEETWATERS – LAKE NAIVASHA

0630hrs: Wake up to a sumptuous buffet breakfast at Sweetwaters Serena Camp and then check out.

0730 hrs Depart after breakfast for Lake Naivasha.

Lake Naivasha is a freshwater lake in the Kenya section of Africa's Great Rift Valley, and is located North West of Nairobi with the town of Naivasha on its north eastern shore. At 1,890 meters (6,200 ft) above sea level, the lake is at the highest point in the Kenyan rift, and is set in a complex geological combination of volcanic rocks and sedimentary deposits from a much larger Pleistocene era lake.

Because the outlet for this ancient lake, now called Njorwa Gorge, is today much higher than the lake, the original Lake Naivasha must have indeed been a truly vast expanse of water. The gorge now forms the entrance to the Hell's Gate National Park which, for obvious reasons, today contains some spectacular examples of water and weather-worn rock formations as well as an abundance of flora and fauna to include some extremely rare, resident breeding pairs of Lammergeyers, otherwise known as Bearded vultures.

1300 hrs Arrival at Lake Naivasha Sopa Resort in time for lunch

Afternoon spent at leisure.

This time can be used doing a boat ride or a visit to Crescent Island – see rates below.

Dinner and then overnight at the Resort.



DAY 05 LAKE NAIVASHA – MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

0630 hrs Enjoy an early morning buffet breakfast at the Resort

0730hrs –Depart for Masai Mara National Reserve, which is also known as the “**Jewell of Kenya**”. On your way to Maasai Mara National Reserve, you will enjoy different array of views which are just priceless.

1240hrs appx: Arrive at Masai Mara National reserve; you will have game drive enroute to your lodge which is Mara Sopa Lodge. You’ll have a sumptuous Lunch at the lodge.

The distance is approximately 4.5 hrs

Spend the afternoon at your own leisure. You can relax in your comfortable room.

Located high on the slopes of the Ololaimutia Hills, Masai Mara Sopa Lodge was one of the first safari lodges to be built in the Maasai Mara Game Reserve, a reason why its gardens and trees are so lush and mature. All the buildings follow the design of traditional African round houses with conical roofs, and these stretch along the line of the hills with the impressively large public area buildings and the swimming pool at their centre.



1600hrs: Enjoy an evening game drive on shared basis to the expansive Mara plains.

The Maasai Mara National Reserve is one of the most popular safari destinations in Africa.

The Maasai Mara is regarded as the jewel of Kenya's wildlife viewing areas. There have been some 95 species of mammals, amphibians and reptiles and over 450 birds species recorded on the reserve.

Nowhere in Africa is wildlife more abundant, and it is for this reason a visitor hardly misses to see the big five (**buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion, and rhino**). Other animals that can be spotted here include hippos, cheetahs, gazelles, antelopes, zebras, giraffes, dik-dik, and warthogs among others.

The annual wildebeest's migration alone involves over 1.5 million wildebeests, zebras, gazelles and other animals that cross over from the Serengeti to the Maasai Mara in search of pasture and water. They cross the Mara River in July and make the return journey in late October/November. The migration, especially the Mara River crossing has been dubbed one of the 8th wonders of the modern world.

DAY 06 ENJOY CAPTIVATING FULL DAY IN THE MAASAI MARA

0630hrs: Wake up for a refreshing hot cup of coffee or tea. Then depart for a morning game drive to explore the Mara plains and its intriguing wildlife.

Alternatively:-

You can opt for a Hot Air Balloon Safari instead of a morning game drive.

This is truly a fun and exciting way to see Africa's landscapes and wildlife.



The trip is magical: spend about one hour floating over the Mara plains. You float in the sky, drift with the whim of the wind, overlooking the plains, just in time to experience a breathtaking sunrise and catch a bird's eye view of the reserve.

The cost includes Balloon Safari + Out of Africa Bush Breakfast. A certificate will be presented by the pilot after the ride.

0830hrs: Return to the lodge for a full buffet breakfast and spend the morning at your own leisure.

1230hrs: Enjoy a scintillating buffet lunch at the lodge.

Afternoon spent at leisure. You can relax by the swimming pool or you can visit a traditional Maasai Village where you'll get insight into the vibrant and traditional way of life of the Maasai.

0730 hrs – check out after bfast and head back to nairobi

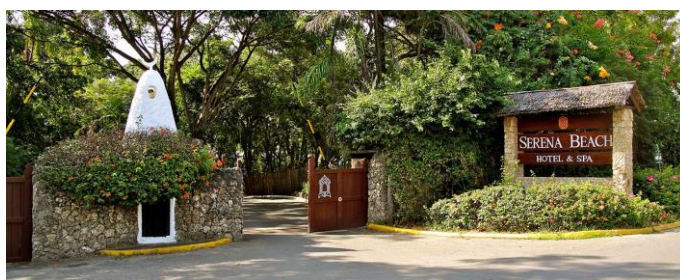
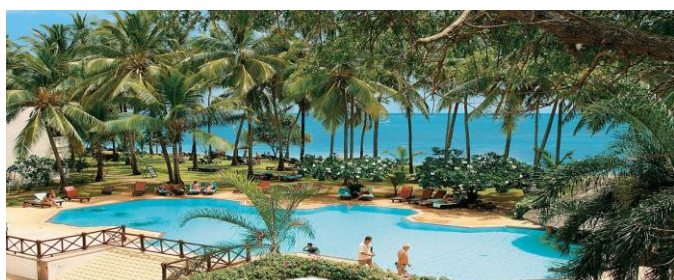
1300 hrs - arrival – lunch on own
