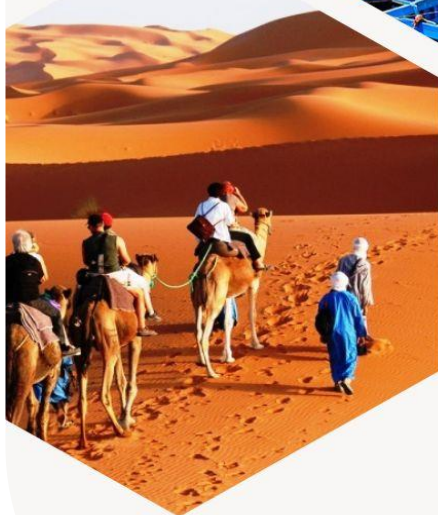

DAY 1: CASABLANCA

- Welcome to Casablanca airport by your driver / guide, (who will be waiting for you at the exit with a sign in your name).
- **Overnight at Casablanca Hotel.**

DAY 2: CASABLANCA - RABAT- TANGIER

- **Breakfast at Casablanca hotel.**
- **Day devoted to Casablanca & Rabat city tour.**
- Visit of the economic capital of Morocco: the central market, the Habous district, the Royal palace, the Mohammed V square, the residential area of Anfa and the outside of the Hassan II Mosque.
- **Continuation to Rabat.**
- City tour including the Royal palace (Mechouar), the Kasbah Oudaya, the Mohammed V mausoleum and the Hassan Tower.
- **Departure to Tangier.**
- **Overnight at Tangier hotel.**



DAY 3: TANGIER - CHEFCHAOUEN - FEZ

- **Breakfast at Tangier hotel.**
- **Half day visit Tangier city tour.**
- Visit to the Kasbah of Tangier: the Kasbah, old palace area, is above the harbor and the city heights. You can also discover prehistoric and ancient remains of Tangier.
- Visit of large and small Socco.
- Visit to the Legation of the United States.
- **Departure to Chefchaouen.**
- Chefchaouen is a popular shopping destination as well, as it offers many native handicrafts that are not available elsewhere in Morocco, such as wool garments and woven blankets. The goat cheese native to the area is also popular with tourists.
- **Departure to Fez.**
- **Overnight at Fez Hotel.**



DAY 4: FEZ

- **Breakfast at Fez hotel.**
- **Full day devoted to Fez city tour.**
- The whole day is devoted to the sightseeing of Fez, the spiritual capital of Morocco.
- The visit of the medieval Medina and its Attarine and Bou Inania Medersas, the Nejjarine fountain and Karaouine mosque.
- Lunch at local restaurant (not included).
- Afternoon, visit of Fez Jdid.

- **Overnight at Fez hotel.**



DAY 5: FEZ - MEKNES - VOLUBILIS

- **Breakfast at Fez hotel.**
- **Day trip to Meknes & Volubilis.**
- **Arrival to Meknes.**
- Begin your tour of Meknes at Bab Mansour. Enter Place El-Hedime (Square of Ruins) which links the medina and the Kasbah. The square is lined with modern residential buildings and a covered food souk (market). Mosque, Menzah (pavilion), courtyard, kitchen and Hammam.
- **Departure to Volubilis.**
- Volubilis has been recognized by UNESCO as a world heritage site and gained international acclaim when Martin Scorsese made it as feature location for his film, The Last Temptation of Christ.
- Begin your visit by discovering the fascinating Roman ruins adorned with beautiful mosaics and colorful tiles depicting Roman mythology. The ruins are spread out across several acres and what remains visible is several fragments of wall, parts of massive columns, the capital, the basilica and a triumphal arch.
- **Return to Fez.**
- **Overnight at Fez hotel.**



DAY 6: FEZ - MIDELT - ERFOUD

- **Breakfast at Fez hotel.**
- **Departure to Erfoud.**
- Departure to Erfoud via the mountains and the cedar woods of the Middle Atlas, passing by Ifrane, a charming ski resort, and Azrou, an important handicraft center.
- Stop in Midelt for lunch (not included).
- Continuation to Erfoud via Errachidia and the Ziz valley, dotted with palm trees, source of the yearly festival in Erfoud.

- **Dinner & Overnight at Erfoud camp.**



DAY 7: ERFOUD - MERZOUGA

- **Breakfast at Erfoud camp.**
- **Departure to Merzouga.**
- You can climb the dunes or you can opt for a camel ride to the top of the dune where you will admire the sunset.
- You take a traditional Bedouin dinner and will spend the night under the starry sky of the desert, in a Bedouin tent.
- **Dinner & Overnight at Merzouga camp.**



DAY 8: MERZOUGA - TINEGHIR - OUARZAZATE

- **Breakfast at Merzouga camp.**
- **Departure to Ouarzazate.**
- Take the road to Rissani, the holy city where Moulay Ali Cherif, ancestor of the Alaouite dynasty is buried.
- Visit of the Kasbah of the 17th century and the Ksar Abbar ruins before continuation to Tinghir via the Tinjdad road.
- Visit of the magnificent Todgha canyons which rocks reach an altitude of 250m.
- Lunch at a restaurant located (not included) the feet of the canyons and departure to the Dades canyons for a visit.
- Continuation to Ouarzazate via the road of the 1000 Kasbahs and the Dades valley, famous for its roses and the yearly Moussem (rose festival).

- **Dinner& Overnight at Ouarzazate hotel.**



DAY 9: OUARZAZATE - TAROUDANT

- **Breakfast at Ouarzazate camp.**
- **Departure to Taroudant.**
- Mountain crossing to Taliouine, capital of saffron. Then we will cross the plain of Souss.
- Visit of the oasis of Tiout and lunch in the oasis.
- Continue to Taroudant and visit this picturesque city still nicknamed "Little Marrakech" and characterized by its belt of red ocher walls surrounded by gardens, eucalyptus, olive trees, pomegranates and palm trees.
- **Dinner & overnight at Taroudant hotel.**



DAY 10: TAROUDANT - AGADIR

- **Breakfast at Taroudant hotel.**
- **Departure to Agadir.**
- Agadir is a major city in Morocco, located on the shore of the Atlantic Ocean near the foot of the Atlas Mountains, just north of the point where the Sous River flows into the ocean.
- It is 508 km south of Casablanca. It is the capital of the Agadir-Ida Ou Tanane Prefecture and of the Massa economic region. A majority of its inhabitants speak Shilha/Tashelhit, a Berber language of the Atlas branch, as their first language.
- **Overnight at Agadir hotel.**



DAY 11: AGADIR - ESSAOUIRA

- **Breakfast at Agadir hotel.**
- **Departure to Essaouira.**
- Visit of the old Mogador, city built by the Portuguese in white and blue colors. Fish lunch facing the ocean.
- Visit of the ramparts and the Medina famous for its crafts and especially for its woodwork.
- Visit the fishing port located at the foot of the ramparts and offers a permanent show in an exuberance of colors.
- Visit of the Navy Gate and the Mellah.
- **Overnight at Essaouira hotel.**



DAY 12: ESSAOUIRA - MARRAKECH

- **Breakfast at Essaouira hotel.**
- **Departure to Marrakech.**
- **Overnight at Marrakech hotel.**

DAY 13: MARRAKECH

- **Breakfast at Marrakech hotel.**
- **Day devoted to Marrakech city tour.**
- The entire day will be devoted to the visit of Marrakesh, the second oldest Imperial city, known as the Pearl of the South.

- The city was founded by the Almoravides at the end of the 11th century.
- The historical sightseeing includes the Menara gardens, the Bahia palace and the Koutoubia.
- Visit of the souks and handicraft quarters, displaying a variety of items and the famous place Djemaa El Fna with its nonstop entertainment.
- **Overnight at Marrakech hotel.**



DAY 14: MARRAKECH - CASABLANCA

- **Breakfast at Marrakech hotel.**
- **Departure to Casablanca.**
- Visit the medina of Casablanca (the visit will take place today if it was not done at the beginning of the tour)
- Day at leisure.
- **Overnight at Casablanca hotel.**

DAY 15: CASABLANCA ... Departure

- **Breakfast at Casablanca hotel.**
- Transfer to Casablanca airport for your departure flight. (Pick up time according to your flight details).
